COURSE PREREQUISITES

This course is designed for learners with little or no previous knowledge of English. Students are expected to be at a Pre-A1 level according to the CEFR. They should be able to recognize and use a limited range of simple words and phrases, and demonstrate readiness to develop basic communication skills in familiar and everyday contexts. No prior formal study of English is required.

COURSE GOALS AND CONTENT

The primary goal of this course is to provide students with a solid foundation in English by following the *Foundation New Languo* coursebook. The content is based on communicative activities that integrate listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills. The book introduces everyday topics such as personal information, family, daily routines, food, city life, and basic cultural elements. The course also incorporates study skills and functional language use to prepare students for real- life communication. By the end of the module, learners will be able to understand and use familiar expressions, introduce themselves and others, ask and answer simple questions about personal details, and interact in a simple way when the other person speaks slowly and clearly.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

Upon completion of the course, students will:

- 1. Recognize and use everyday words and expressions related to immediate needs (e.g., personal information, family, daily activities).
- 2. Understand and respond to very simple spoken and written texts with familiar vocabulary.
- 3. Introduce themselves and provide basic personal details (name, nationality, age, family, likes/dislikes).
- 4. Ask and answer simple questions in predictable, routine situations.
- 5. Develop confidence in participating in classroom activities through role-play, pair work, and guided tasks.
- 6. Begin to use simple strategies for learning, such as asking for clarification or repetition.

SPECIFIC COURSE OBJECTIVES

By the end of each unit in *Foundation New Languo*, students will be able to:

- 1. Greet people, say goodbye, introduce themselves, spell names, ask and answer questions about personal details
- 2. Talk about family members, describe people's physical appearance, use possessive forms
- 3. Talk about daily routines and habits, express frequency with adverbs, describe a room using prepositions
- 4. Identify food and drinks, talk about sports, give and follow simple recipes, express likes/dislikes
- 5. Describe places in town, talk about houses and rooms, ask and give directions
- 6. Name common animals, talk about environmental problems in simple terms, use *can/can't* and *should/shouldn't* for advice
- 7. Use simple past tense to talk about famous people, share short biographical details
- 8. Read short passages about history and culture, talk about past events using simple past forms
