COURSE PREREQUISITES

This course is designed for learners who have successfully completed A1 English or demonstrate equivalent knowledge. Students are expected to understand and use simple sentences, describe familiar topics, and interact in short conversations. They should be able to write short texts such as simple emails or notes. The course builds on this foundation and prepares learners to operate more confidently in everyday and academic contexts at the A2 level.

COURSE GOALS AND CONTENT

The goal of this course is to raise students' English proficiency from A1 to A2 level, using A2 New Languo as the core textbook. The course develops listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills in an integrated way. Content focuses on themes such as self-discovery, environmental awareness, history, technology and innovation, art and design, economy, social awareness, and daily life. Each unit introduces essential vocabulary, grammar, and functional language, supported by communicative activities, study skills, and writing

practice. By the end of the course, learners will be able to understand sentences and frequently used expressions related to personal and social topics, describe experiences and events, give opinions, and communicate in simple but connected discourse.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

Upon completion of the course, students will be able to:

- 1. Understand the main ideas in short, clear, simple messages and announcements.
- 2. Participate in routine conversations about familiar and everyday topics, exchanging information in simple terms.
- 3. Describe experiences, past events, and personal plans using appropriate verb forms.
- 4. Express likes, dislikes, preferences, and opinions on familiar matters.
- 5. Read and understand short texts such as stories, news articles, and simple academic passages.
- 6. Write connected sentences to describe events, give reasons, and produce short paragraphs and guided compositions.
- 7. Develop strategies to maintain interaction, such as asking for clarification, repeating information, or confirming understanding.

SPECIFIC COURSE OBJECTIVES

By the end of each unit in A2 New Languo, students will be able to:

- 1. Talk about personality traits, express routines and activities, describe classmates, and use present simple and continuous forms to exchange personal information.
- 2. Discuss environmental issues, describe dates, events, and places, use connectors and prepositions of time and place, and write short texts about protecting the environment.
- 3. Talk about historical figures, narrate past events, and use simple past and past continuous to describe personal and historical experiences.
- 4. Discuss technology and its impact, compare people and things using comparatives and superlatives, and give opinions in simple discussions.
- 5. Talk about art and design, describe future plans and predictions using *will*, *be going to*, and present continuous for the future, and write descriptive and creative texts.
- 6. Use everyday economic vocabulary, talk about money management and shopping, express possibilities with modals, and use conditionals to discuss real and imagined situations.
- 7. Discuss social issues, express needs and abilities, and use present perfect tense with *too* and *enough* to talk about community and personal experiences.
- 8. Talk about routines and lifestyle choices, describe emotions and habits, conduct surveys, and use gerunds and infinitives to express preferences and routines.
